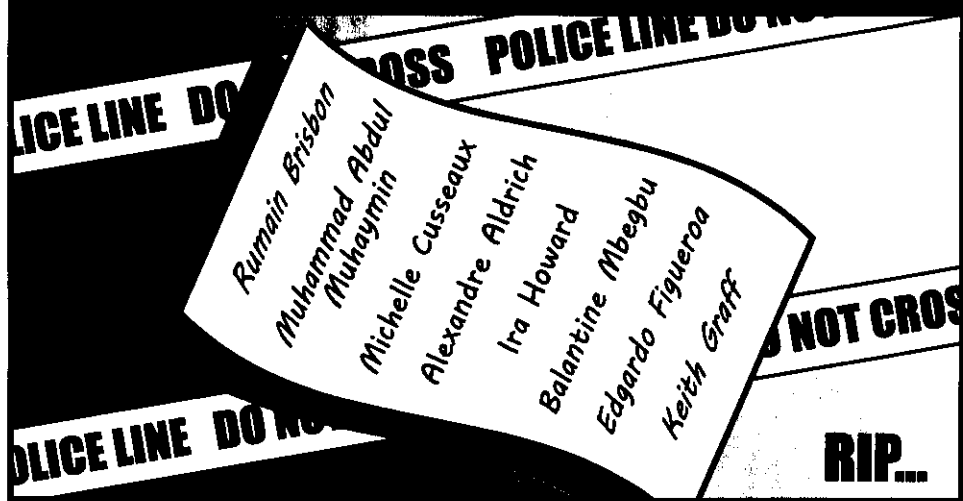

7: Phoenix Police kill unarmed people.



Less than 1% of cops that murder people  
ever face criminal convictions.

2: Phoenix Police lead the nation in officer involved shootings.



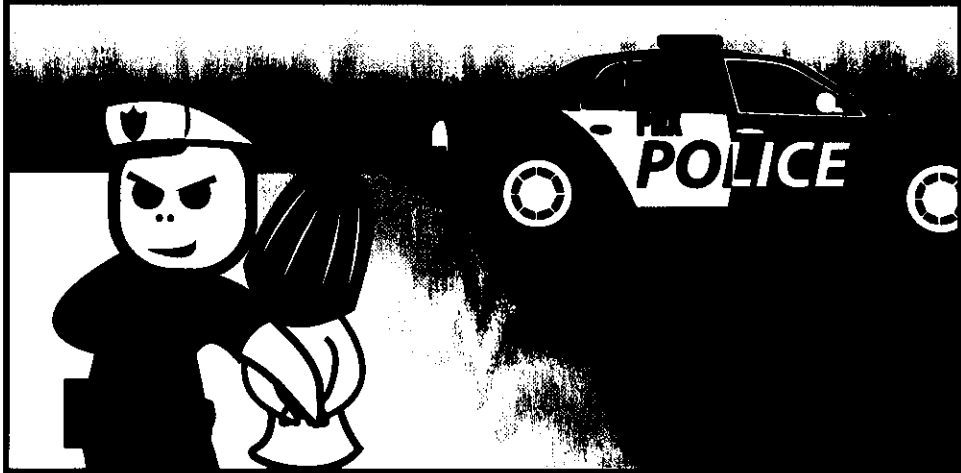
Phoenix cops have shot more people this year than all these other cities **combined**.

3: Phoenix police collaborate with ICE to target immigrants.



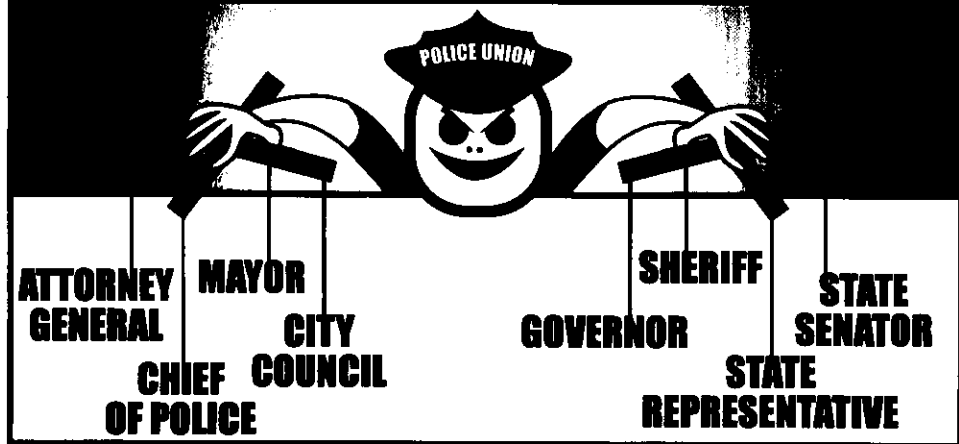
Phoenix cops transfer people to Immigration and Customs Enforcement for deportation.

4: Phoenix police cover up sexual assaults committed by cops.



Cops who rape and sexually abuse people are protected by police unions and seldom face justice for their criminal actions.

5: Phoenix police advocate for racist and anti-immigrant laws like SB1070.



*Police use their power to pass laws that criminalize people of color. Then demand more taxpayer money to enforce these laws against our community.*

6: Phoenix police can't be trusted to handle mental health calls.



My son hadn't taken his medication, so I called the cops to help me calm him down and they showed up and killed him...

Too many calls for help end up with the cop shooting people who are bipolar, depressed, or have substance abuse issues.



*7: Phoenix police hide records of police abuse from the public.*

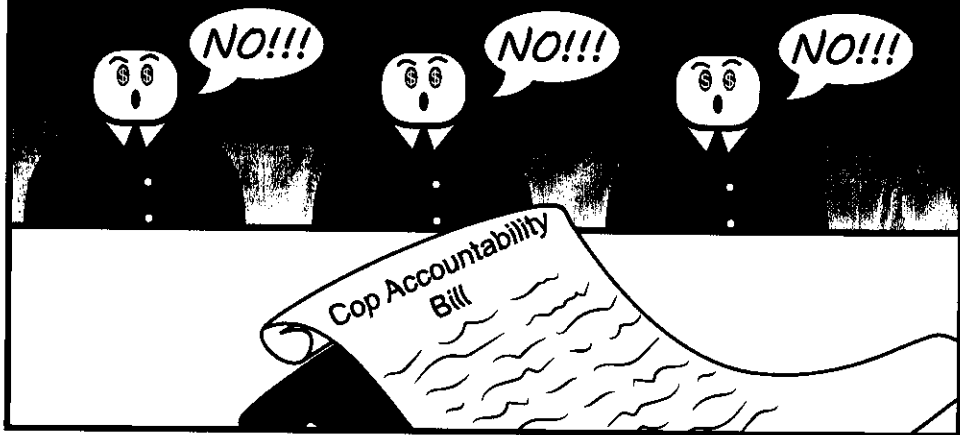
*Police refuse to acknowledge their abuse, conceal records of bad cops, and delay the release of public information for months and sometimes years.*

9: Phoenix police block laws that would hold cops responsible for abuse.



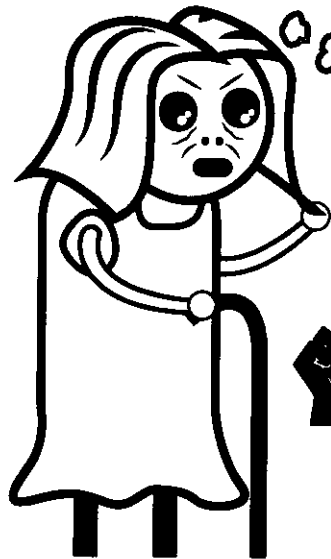
The police use their power to deny justice to the community. That's why we need oversight and independent investigations.
